## Let's Get Ready Wins \$500K in Chase American Giving Awards

# Federal Budget Retains Maximum Pell, Trims Years of Eligibility

In December, Congress finalized an agreement to fund the federal government for the remainder of federal fiscal year 2012, which ends on September 30, 2012. Most educational programs of interest to the college access and success community received level funding or small changes from FY11. One item of note is the small \$15 million increase to TRiO programs.
